

Environmental Policy

We are committed to:

- Eliminating our consumption of fuel for heating and hot water we have installed ground source heat pumps which heats our hot water and uses no external fuel.
- Reducing our consumption of electricity. Most of our light bulbs are low energy and low wattage and we always make sure to turn any unneeded lights off.
- Using Ecoballs when doing laundry. These eliminate the need for washing powder therefore reducing chemicals and packaging. Ecoballs ionise the water helping it to get deep into the laundry and lift the dirt away.
- Recycling all paper, glass and aluminium.
- Ensuring all our cleaning chemicals are chlorine free.
- Ensuring that our suppliers understand our environmental policy, and encourage them in developing responsible behaviour with regard to the environment.
- Regularly assessing processes and achievement in environmental practices.

During your stay with us we ask you to help us in a few simple ways.

- Please switch off all lights when you leave your room and try not to leave the TV on stand-by.
- Please note our towel policy, if you require your towels to be changed please place on the shower room floor. Any towels left on rails or hooks will not be changed.

- Please use public transport as much as possible during your stay. We can provide bus timetables, cycle route information and even have a few bikes you can borrow.
